Simon Poulter and Sophie Mellor's project, "We Are Making A Film About Mark Fisher" is a fascinating exercise in making a film out of a thinker's body of work. They have toured their film on Fisher's philosophy at various venues across the UK and Europe to considerable acclaim. In this workshop, Poulter introduces us to the process of turning research into film, explains how to promote a film across social media, and considers what are the ethical dilemmas of interacting with Fisher's life and thought on the big screen.

Participation in this workshop is recommended to AU staff and students with an interest in research dissemination, especially in the intersection between academia and the creative arts, and indeed in fans of Mark Fisher's corpus, particularly *Capitalist Realism*.
